



Bogota. D.C. July 5, 2017. Regarding the press note published by the news website Primera Página related with the claims made by Councilman Antonio Sanguino, Empresa de Energía de Bogotá hereby clarifies:

- EEB is unaware of any links that may exist between Peruvian company Graña y Montero with the Odebrecht company.
- The press note confuses information referring to the concession contract signed to build the South Peruvian Gas Pipeline, assigned in June 2014 by the Government of Peru to the company Empresa Gasoducto Surperuano S.A., which comprises the firms Graña y Montero and Odebrecht, among others, to transport gas from the Anta Province (Cusco) to the South Coast. The aforementioned project has no relation whatsoever with the concession contract for gas distribution in the Peruvian Region of ICA, where CONTUGAS, a company within the umbrella of Grupo Energía de Bogotá, operates.
- In consequence, EEB, directly or indirectly via the companies comprising the Group it spearheads, has never had a partnership relation with Graña y Montero. Its sole relation with the aforementioned company was a construction contract where Graña y Montero had the role of contractor and which ended in 2014.
- The concession contract signed by CONTUGAS with the State of Peru for the design and operation of a natural gas distribution system in the ICA Region (the towns Pisco, Chincha, Ica, Nasca and Marcona) has been duly complied with, and the natural gas distribution system in the ICA Department has been operational since the year 2013.
